

CRRSAA and ARP Student Grant Programs

Ecumenical Theological Seminary (OPE ID: 04002400) received funds under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) Programs. Under CRRSAA section 314(d)(7), which continues to apply to ARP (a)(4) funds, awards from the Proprietary Institution Grant Funds for Students Program may only be used to provide financial aid grants to students (including students exclusively enrolled in distance education), which may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or child care. In making such financial aid grants to students, ETS must prioritize grants to students with exceptional need.

1. ETS signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution will use the applicable amount of funds designated under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
2. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is \$27,705.
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs as of 3/31/2022 is \$0. ETS is assessing student funding needs, and we will begin allocating funds for targeted student tuition support and student services in the second quarter of 2022.
4. The estimated total number of students at the institution that are eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is 86.
5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs is zero. ETS is assessing student funding needs, and we will begin allocating funds for targeted student tuition support and student services in the second quarter of 2022.
